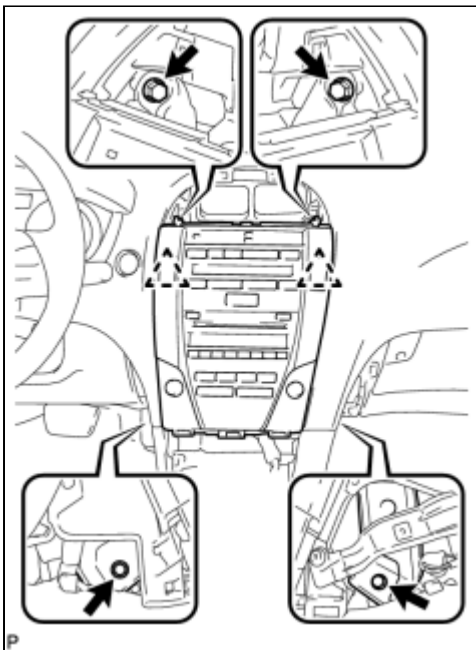

6. REMOVE INTEGRATION CONTROL PANEL WITH RADIO RECEIVER ASSEMBLY (w/o Navigation System)



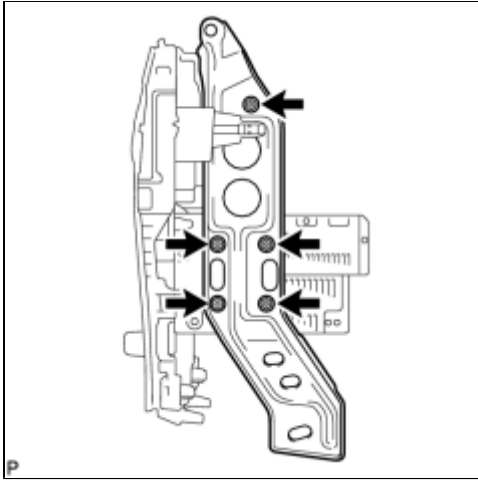
(a) Remove the 4 bolts.

(b) Pull the integration control panel with radio receiver assembly toward the rear of the vehicle and disengage the 2 clips.

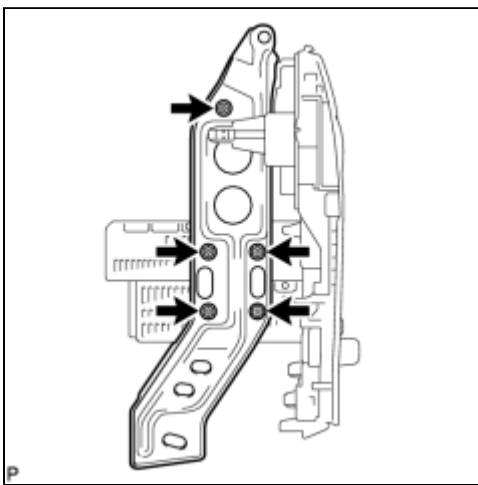
(c) Disconnect each connector and remove the integration control panel with radio receiver assembly.

(a) Remove the 4 bolts, screw, and No. 1 radio bracket.



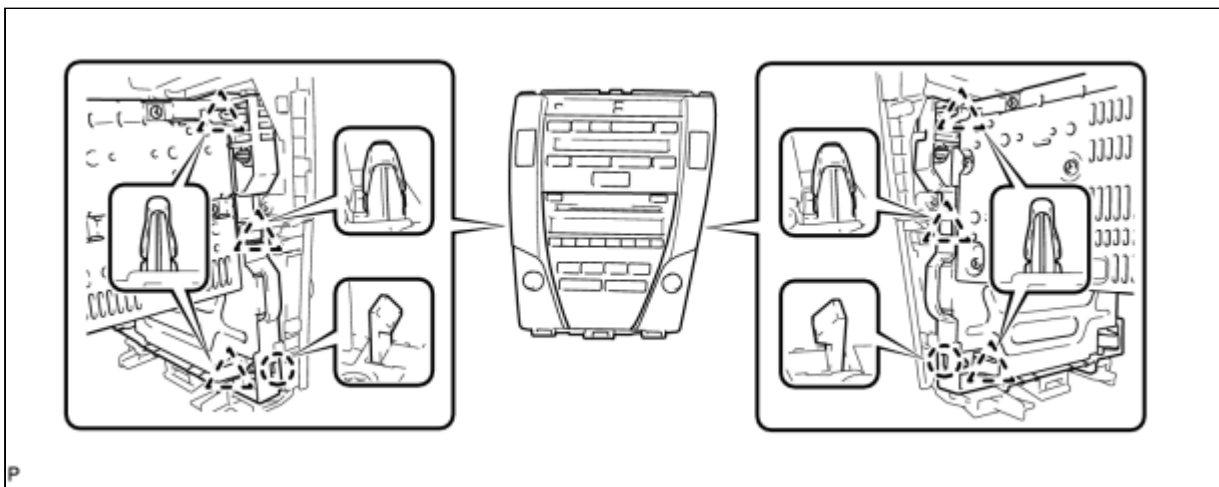
**8. REMOVE NO. 2 RADIO BRACKET (w/o Navigation System)**



(a) Remove the 4 bolts, screw, and No. 2 radio bracket.

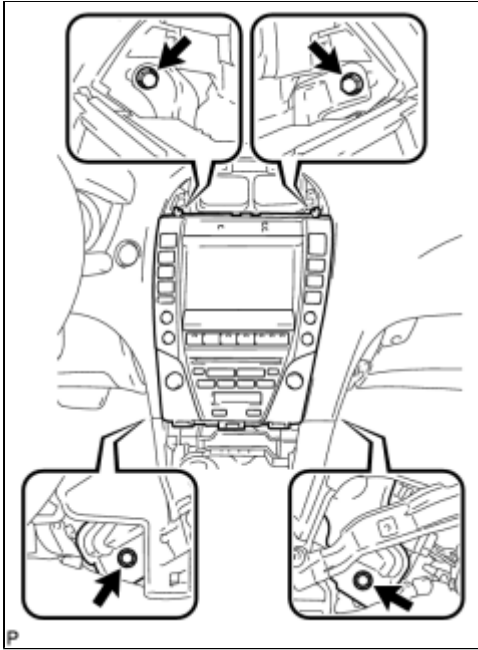
**9. REMOVE RADIO RECEIVER ASSEMBLY (w/o Navigation System)**

**10. REMOVE MULTI-DISPLAY WITH RADIO RECEIVER ASSEMBLY (w/ Navigation System)**

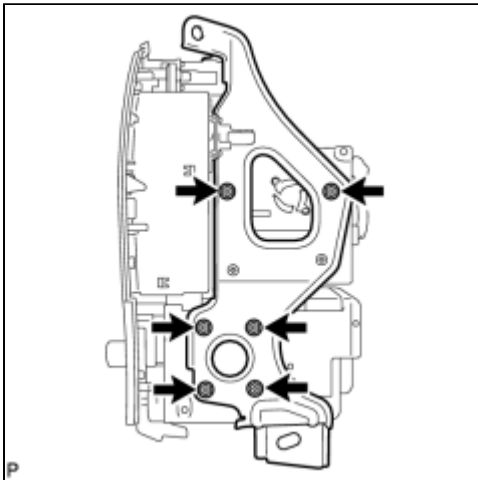


(a) Remove the 4 bolts.

(b) Pull the multi-display with radio receiver assembly toward the rear of the vehicle and disengage the 2 clips.

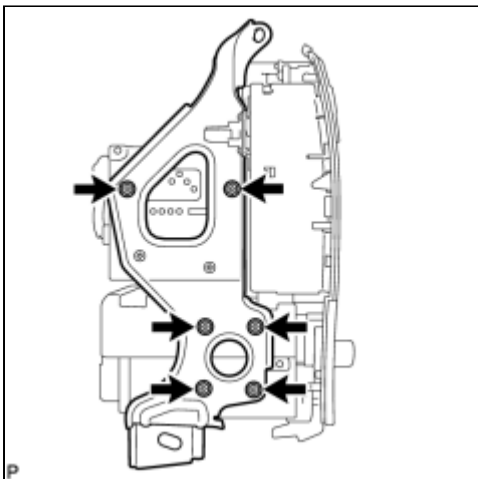
(c) Disconnect each connector and remove the multi-display with radio receiver assembly.

(a) Remove the 6 bolts and No. 1 radio bracket.

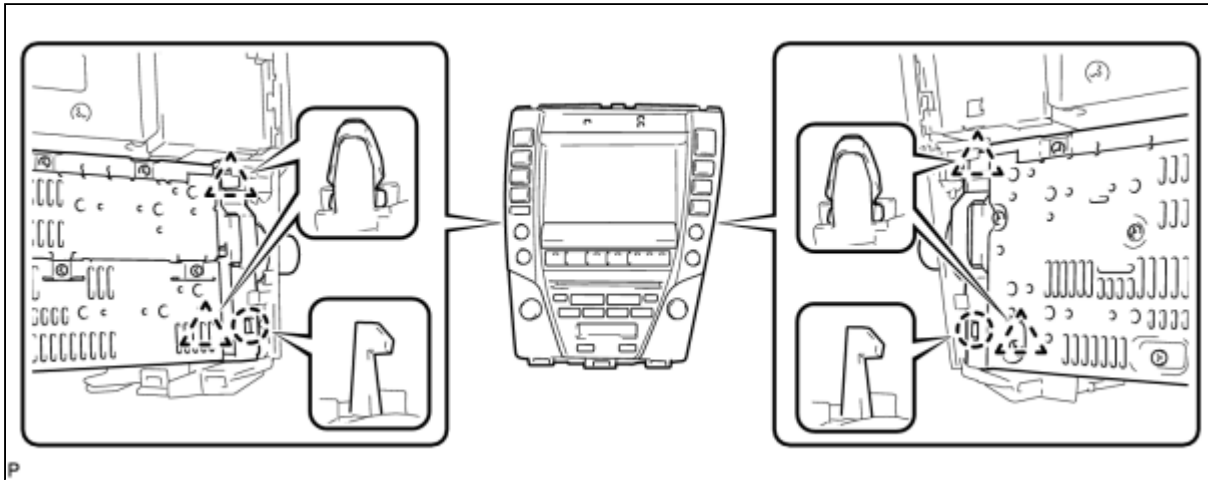
### 12. REMOVE NO. 2 RADIO BRACKET (w/ Navigation System)
