


#### **INSPECT SLIDING ROOF GLASS ALIGNMENT**

(a) Start the engine and check the operation time of the sliding roof.

#### Operation time:

Approx. 5 sec.


- (b) Check for abnormal noise or binding during operation.
- (c) With the sliding roof fully closed, check for water leakage.
- (d) Check for a difference in level between the sliding roof weatherstrip and roof panel.



 $0 \pm 1.5$  mm (0  $\pm 0.059$  in.)


Rear end:

(e) Check for a clearance between the sliding roof glass and roof panel.


 $17.5 \pm 0.5$  mm (0.689  $\pm$  0.020 in.)



### If the sliding roof does not operate:

HINT: Tape a screwdriver tip before use.


(f) Using the screwdriver, remove the interior light cover.




(g) Remove the large screw inside.

NOTICE: Be careful not to lose the spring washer or shim.

(h) Manually operate the moon roof by inserting a special crank-shaped screwdriver into the hole and turning the drive shaft.






## SLIDING ROOF ADJUSTMENT

#### 1. REMOVE SLIDING ROOF GARNISHES


Before making adjustments, remove the left and right sliding roof garnishes.

HINT: After adjustment, reinstall the sliding roof garnishes.




#### 2. TO ADJUST LEVEL DIFFERENCE

Adjust by increasing or decreasing the number of shims between the bracket and sliding roof.




#### 3. TO ADJUST FORWARD OR REARWARD

(a) Adjust by loosening the sliding roof installation nuts, and move the sliding roof bracket forward and backward.



- (b) When the front or rear alignment is not correct, remove the glass and adjust the drive rail.
- (c) Using a screwdriver, slide the link forward or backward to align the two marks as shown.
- (d) Slide the bracket to the front with your hand.



#### 4. TO ADJUST RIGHT OR LEFT

Adjust by loosening the sliding roof rear shoe installation nuts, and move the sliding roof to the right and left.

#### 5. TO ADJUST CLEARANCE

#### (Difference in left and right clearance)


Adjust by loosening the sliding roof installation nuts and readjust the sliding roof to the proper position.

## **SLIDING ROOF REMOVAL**

1. DISCONNECT BATTERY CABLE FROM NEGATIVE TERMINAL


CAUTION: Work must be started after 90 seconds from the time the ignition switch is turned to the "LOCK" position and the negative (-) terminal cable is disconnected from the battery.



#### 2. REMOVE FRONT DOOR SCUFF PLATE

HINT: Tape a screwdriver tip before use.


- (a) Using the screwdriver, pry out the front side of the clip.
- (b) Using a clip remover, remove the scuff plate.



#### 3. REMOVE REAR DOOR SCUFF PLATE


HINT: Tape a screwdriver tip before use.

- (a) Using the screwdriver, pry out the rear side of the clip.
- (b) Using a clip remover, remove the scuff plate.



#### 4. REMOVE CENTER PILLAR LOWER GARNISH


HINT: Tape a screwdriver tip before use. Using the screwdriver, remove garnish.



#### 5. REMOVE FRONT SEAT BELT SHOULDER ANCHOR


HINT: Tape a screwdriver tip before use.

- (a) Using the screwdriver, pry out the shoulder anchor cover.
- (b) Remove the front seat belt shoulder anchor.



#### 6. REMOVE FRONT SEAT BELT RETRACTOR

- (a) Disconnect the connectors.
- (b) Remove two bolts and the retractor.




#### 7. REMOVE SEAT TRACK COVER

HINT: Tape a screwdriver tip before use. Using the screwdriver, pry out four covers.


#### 8. REMOVE FRONT SEAT

- (a) Remove four bolts.
- (b) Disconnect the connector.
- (c) Remove the front seat with the seat belt.




#### 9. REMOVE REAR SEAT CUSHION

Pull up the front portion of the rear seat cushion.



#### 10. REMOVE REAR SEATBACK


- (a) Disconnect the seat belt from the belt guide.
- (b) Remove four bolts.
- (c) Pull up the seatback to remove it.



#### 11. REMOVE ROOF SIDE INNER GARNISH

HINT: Tape a screwdriver tip before use.


- (a) Using the screwdriver, remove the garnish.
- (b) Disconnect the connector.



#### 12. REMOVE FRONT PILLAR GARNISH

HINT: Tape a screwdriver tip before use.


- (a) Using the screwdriver, pry out the clips.
- (b) Pull the garnish rearward to remove it.



#### 13. REMOVE CENTER VISOR

HINT: Tape a screwdriver tip before use.


- (a) Using the screwdriver, remove the center visor cover.
- (b) Remove two screws and the center visor.



#### 14. REMOVE SUNVISOR AND HOLDER

HINT: Tape a screwdriver tip before use.


- (a) Using the screwdriver, remove the sunvisor bracket cover.
- (b) Remove two screws and the sunvisor.
- (c) Disconnect the connector.
- (d) Remove the screw and the holder.



#### 15. REMOVE SLIDING ROOF SWITCH

HINT: Tape a screwdriver tip before use.


- (a) Using the screwdriver, remove the cover.
- (b) Remove three screws and the switch, then disconnect the connector.



#### 16. REMOVE ASSIST GRIP


HINT: Tape a screwdriver tip before use.

- (a) Using the screwdriver, remove the cover.
- (b) Remove two screws and the assist grip.




#### 17. REMOVE ROOF HEADLINING

(a) Remove eight hook fasteners, and three clips around the sliding roof opening.



- (b) Using a clip remover, remove four clips from the rear of the roof headlining.
- (c) Slide the roof headlining toward the vehicle rear to remove it.

  NOTICE: Do not fold down the headlining.



#### 18. REMOVE SLIDING ROOF GLASS

HINT: Tape a screwdriver tip before use.


(a) Using the screwdriver, remove the garnishes.

NOTICE: Do not scratch the glass or garnish with the screwdriver.

(b) Remove six nuts and shims.


HINT: Make sure of the number of shims.

(c) Pull the glass upward to remove it.



#### 19. REMOVE SLIDING ROOF CONTROL RELAY

- (a) Disconnect the connector.
- (b) Remove the bolt and the relay.





#### 20. REMOVE DRIVE GEAR ASSEMBLY

- (a) Disconnect the connectors.
- (b) Remove four bolts and the gear assembly.

#### 21. REMOVE SLIDING ROOF HOUSING

- (a) Disconnect the four drain hoses from the housing.
- (b) Remove eight bolts, six nuts and the housing.






# SLIDING ROOF DISASSEMBLY AND ASSEMBLY

HINT: Assemble the sliding roof parts by following the disassembly sequence in reverse.


1. REMOVE ROOF DRIP CHANNEL

Remove two screws and the channel.




#### 2. REMOVE WIND DEFLECTOR PANEL

(a) Using a screwdriver, slide the drive cable backward.




(b) Remove four screws and the panel.




#### 3. REMOVE SLIDING ROOF CABLE GUIDE CASING

(a) Remove two screws and the sliding roof guide rail cover.




- (b) Remove two screws.
- (c) Pull the cable guide casing toward the front.
- (d) Pull the driver cable out of the cable guide casing.




#### 4. REMOVE SLIDING ROOF DRIVE RAIL

- (a) Remove two screws.
- (b) Pull the drive rail forward while lifting its front side up, and release the drive rail from the hook at the rear of the housing.



- (c) Remove the drive rail.
- REMOVE STOPPER
  Remove the screw and the stopper.
- 6. REMOVE SUNSHADE TRIM




#### 7. REMOVE DRIVE RAIL STOPPER

Remove the screw and the stopper from the rail.

#### 8. REMOVE DRIVE CABLE

Pull the drive cable from the rail.



## SLIDING ROOF GLASS DISASSEMBLY AND ASSEMBLY



## INSTALL SLIDING ROOF PARTS BY FOLLOWING RE-MOVAL SEQUENCE IN REVERSE ADJUST DRIVE RAIL

HINT: Adjust the drive rail to a closed and tilted down position.

- (a) Using a screwdriver, slide the link forward or backward to align the two marks as shown.
- (b) Slide the bracket to the forefront with your hand.

## ADJUST AND INSTALL DRIVE GEAR ASSEMBLY

- (a) Remove the screw and cam plate cover.
- (b) Remove the large screw, washers and shims.
- (c) Turn the drive shaft by screwdriver to align the housing and gear point mark as shown.
- (d) Install cam plate cover with a screw.
- (e) Install the drive gear assembly with four bolts.
- (f) Connect the connectors.

#### **TORQUE FOLLOWING BOLTS:**

(a) Rear seatback

Torque: 18 N·m (185 kgf·cm, 13 ft·lbf)

(b) Front seat

Torque: 37 N·m (375 kgf·cm, 27 ft·lbf)

(c) Front seat retractor (Upper Side)

Torque: 19 N·m (195 kgf·cm, 14 ft·lbf)

(d) Front seat retractor (Lower Side)

Torque: 43 N m (440 kgf cm, 32 ft lbf)

(e) Front seat belt shoulder anchor

Torque: 43 N·m (440 kgf·cm, 32 ft·lbf)
