1. PRECAUTION

CAUTION:

Be sure to read Precaution thoroughly before servicing (Click here).

NOTICE:

After turning the engine switch off, waiting time may be required before disconnecting the cable from the negative (-) battery terminal. Therefore, make sure to read the disconnecting the cable from the negative (-) battery terminal notices before proceeding with work (<u>Click here</u>).


2. DISCONNECT CABLE FROM NEGATIVE BATTERY TERMINAL

CAUTION:

Wait at least 90 seconds after disconnecting the cable from the negative (-) battery terminal to disable the SRS system.

3. REMOVE LOWER NO. 3 STEERING WHEEL COVER

a. Using a screwdriver with its tip wrapped with protective tape, detach the claw to remove the lower No. 3 steering wheel cover.



4. REMOVE LOWER NO. 2 STEERING WHEEL COVER

a. Using a screwdriver with its tip wrapped with protective tape, detach the claw to remove the lower No. 2 steering wheel cover.



5. REMOVE STEERING PAD

CAUTION:


When storing the steering pad, keep the airbag deployment side facing upward.

- a. Check that the engine switch is off.
- **b.** Check that the cable is disconnected from the negative (-) battery terminal.

CAUTION:

Wait at least 90 seconds after disconnecting the cable from the negative (-) battery terminal to disable the SRS system.

c. Using a screwdriver, push the 3 torsion springs to detach the 3 pins as shown in the illustration.



d. Pull out the steering pad from the steering wheel assembly and support the steering pad with one hand as shown in the illustration.

NOTICE:

When removing the steering pad, do not pull the airbag wire harness.

- **e.** Disconnect the horn connector from the steering pad.
- **f.** Using a screwdriver with its tip wrapped with protective tape, release the 2 airbag connector locks.
- **g.** Disconnect the 2 airbag connectors to remove the steering pad as shown in the illustration.
