


7. REMOVE FRONT DOOR SCUFF PLATE RH

HINT:

Use the same procedure described for the LH side.

8. REMOVE FRONT DOOR OPENING TRIM COVER LH

a. Detach the 5 claws and remove the front door opening trim cover LH.



9. REMOVE FRONT DOOR OPENING TRIM COVER RH

HINT:

Use the same procedure described for the LH side.

10. REMOVE FRONT PILLAR GARNISH LH


a. Pull the upper part of the garnish toward the inside of the cabin and detach the 2 clips.

HINT:

Make the front pillar garnish LH hang down from the front pillar garnish clip.

b. Turn the end of the front pillar garnish clip 90° with needle-nose pliers and remove it from the front pillar garnish LH.

NOTICE:


- Front pillar garnish clips are reusable if they are not removed from the vehicle and have no damage.
- Replace the front pillar garnish clips with new ones if they are removed from the vehicle.

HINT:

Tape the tips of the needle-nose pliers before use.


- *1 Front Pillar Garnish Clip
 *2 Protective Tape
- c. Detach the guide and remove the front pillar garnish LH.
- d. Protect the curtain shield airbag assembly.



 Completely cover the airbag with a cloth or nylon sheet and secure the ends of the cover with adhesive tape as shown in the illustration.

NOTICE:

Cover the curtain shield airbag with a protective cover as soon as the front pillar garnish is removed.

11. REMOVE FRONT PILLAR GARNISH RH

HINT:


Use the same procedure described for the LH side.

12. REMOVE INSTRUMENT SIDE PANEL LH

a. Put protective tape around the instrument side panel LH.

- *1 Protective Tape
- Using a moulding remover, detach the 7 clips and remove the instrument side panel LH.




13. REMOVE NO. 1 INSTRUMENT PANEL GARNISH SUB-ASSEMBLY

a. Put protective tape around the No. 1 instrument panel garnish sub-assembly.


Text in Illustration

- *1 Protective Tape
- **b.** Using a moulding remover, detach the 4 clips and remove the No. 1 instrument panel garnish sub-assembly.




14. REMOVE NO. 1 INSTRUMENT PANEL UNDER COVER SUB-ASSEMBLY

- a. Remove the 3 screws <A>.
- **b.** Detach the 2 claws.
- c. Disconnect the connectors, detach the clamp and remove the No. 1 instrument panel under cover sub-assembly.



15. REMOVE NO. 1 INSTRUMENT PANEL SAFETY PAD SUB-ASSEMBLY

- a. Detach the 9 clips and guide.
- **b.** Disconnect the connectors and remove the No. 1 instrument panel safety pad subassembly.



16. REMOVE LOWER NO. 1 INSTRUMENT PANEL AIRBAG ASSEMBLY

CAUTION:

When storing the lower No. 1 instrument panel airbag assembly, keep the airbag deployment side facing upward.

- **a.** Check that the engine switch is off.
- **b.** Check that the cable is disconnected from the negative (-) battery terminal.
