REMOVAL

- 1. DISCHARGE FUEL SYSTEM PRESSURE
- 2. DISCONNECT CABLE FROM NEGATIVE BATTERY TERMINAL


Wait at least 90 seconds after disconnecting the cable from the negative (-) battery terminal to prevent airbag and seat belt pretensioner activation.

NOTICE:


After the engine switch is turned off, the HDD navigation system requires approximately 6 minutes to record various types of memory and settings. As a result, after turning the engine switch off, wait 6 minutes or more before disconnecting the cable from the negative (-) battery terminal.

- 3. REMOVE TIMING CHAIN COVER SUB-ASSEMBLY
 - (a) Remove the timing chain cover .
- 4. SET NO. 1 CYLINDER TO TDC / COMPRESSION
- 5. REMOVE NO. 1 CHAIN TENSIONER ASSEMBLY (for Bank 1)
- 6. REMOVE CHAIN TENSIONER SLIPPER (for Bank 1)
- 7. REMOVE NO. 1 CHAIN VIBRATION DAMPER (for Bank 1)
- 8. REMOVE CHAIN SUB-ASSEMBLY (for Bank 1) NO
- 9. REMOVE NO. 3 CHAIN TENSIONER ASSEMBLY
- 10. REMOVE CAMSHAFT BEARING CAP (for Bank 1)

(a) Make sure that the knock pin of the camshaft is positioned as shown in the illustration.




(b) Uniformly loosen and remove the 8 bearing cap bolts in the sequence shown in the illustration.



(c) Uniformly loosen and remove the 18 bearing cap bolts in the sequence shown in the illustration.

NOTICE:

Uniformly loosen the bolts while keeping the camshaft level.



(d) Remove the 7 bearing caps.

HINT:

Arrange the removed parts in the correct order.

(e) Remove the No. 3 and No. 4 camshafts.

11. REMOVE CAMSHAFT HOUSING SUB-ASSEMBLY (for Bank 1)

(a) Remove the camshaft housing by prying between the cylinder head and camshaft housing with a screwdriver.

NOTICE:

Be careful not to damage the contact surfaces of the cylinder head and camshaft housing.

HINT:

Tape the screwdriver tip before use.
